Improving Public, Business, and Public Sector Awareness Through Promoting Government-wide Anti-Corruption & Integrity Policies



- ✓ In 2025, perceptions regarding unfairness and corruption in Korean society among the general public and businesspeople improved significantly compared to 2024.



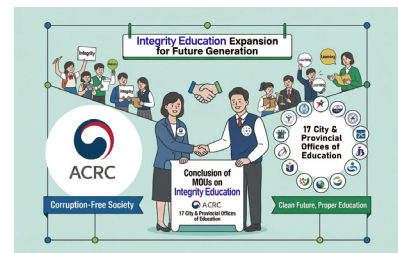

Building Integrity Education Infrastructure for Future Generations



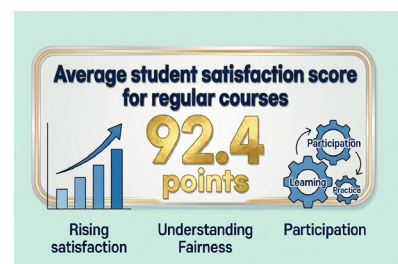
Elementary, Middle, and High School Students

- ✓ Concluded Integrity Education MOUs for Students with all 17 regional Offices of Education (as of Dec. 2025)
 - * Developed integrity education contents for distribution to elementary school students, reaching 38,000+ students (as of Nov. 2025)



University Students

- ✓ Signed integrity education MOUs (27 universities), and hosted special lectures on Integrity (49 times, attended by 5,618 students as of June 2026)
 - Regular courses were launched in 4 universities in 2025, achieving a high average student satisfaction score of 92.4 points

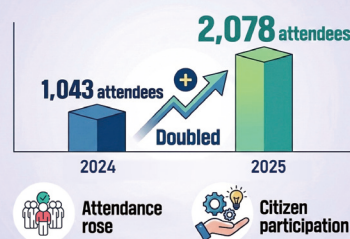
Supporting Ethical Management

- ✓ ACRC **provides expert diagnostics and consulting services** regarding corporate ethical management status.
 - * 10 private companies and 10 public corporations selected to be supported (as of 2026)
- ✓ ACRC **pushed for amendments to the Anti-Corruption and ACRC Act** to spread integrity and ethical management (submitted to the National Assembly on June 4, 2026)
 - Corporate ethical management-related policy promotion duties added to the functions of ACRC; independence for public institutions' anti-corruption operations secured; and ethical management compliance system operated

Enhancing Civic Capacity

- ✓ **Professionalism and participation of citizen integrity auditors improved through workshops** (3 times)
 - * Workshop attendance doubled from 1,043 participants in 2024 to 2,078 participants in 2025

Workshop Attendance Status



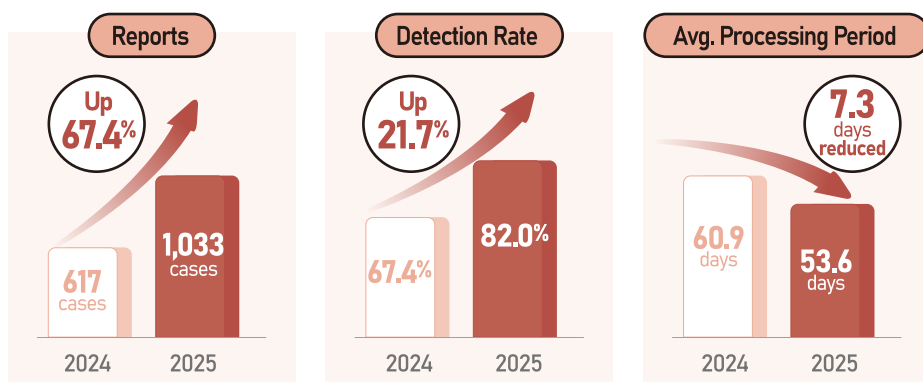

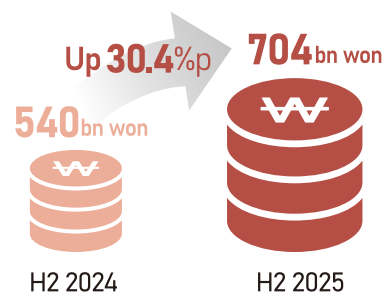
Active Case Processing

- Ensuring fairness in hiring employees across 51 central administrative agencies



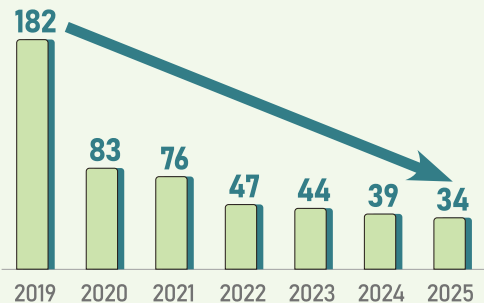

- ✓ 1 division → expanded to 2 divisions (Dec. 2025)

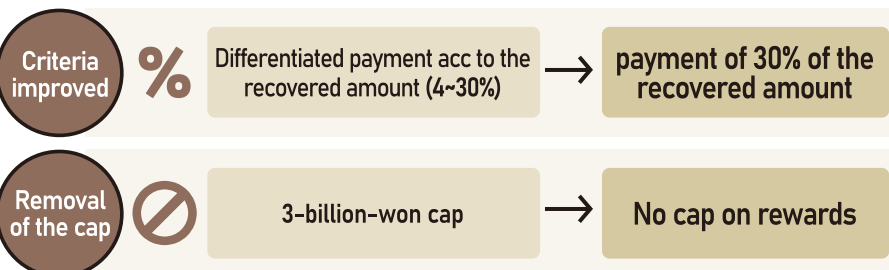

42 bn recovered to net revenue

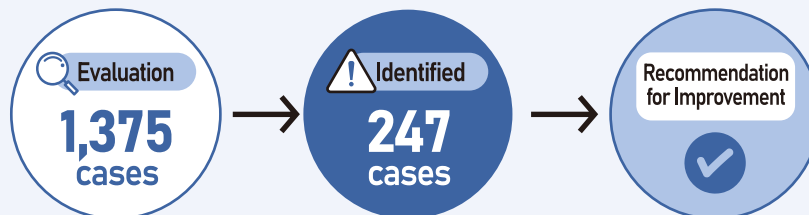

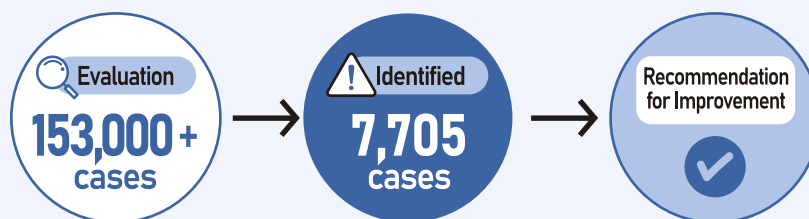
Evaluation of Central Government's Enacted/Amended Laws (2025)
